BEST EVENT: ESTATE FIORENTINA 2024, THE SUMMER LONG FESTIVAL OF EVENTS AND PERFORMANCES THROUGHOUT FLORENCE, May until September

For the Florentine Summer 2024, 10 major festivals return that form the central focus of this summer explosion of arts and culture! The events span from music, cultural debates, art exhibitions, and itinerant tours to discover Florence, all the way through to literary festivals and live talk shows. We are set for a summer of creativity and entertainment! The featured festivals are: **Apriti Cinema in the Uffizi Square** (that includes the film festivals: Festival dei Popoli, Lo Schermo dell'arte, Nice, Middle East), **Secret Florence** (made up of Fabbrica Europa, Lo Schermo dell'Arte, Musicus Concentus, Tempo Reale, and Danza Virgilio Sieni), **Controradio**, **La Citta dei Lettori**, **Sagrati in Musica sotto le stelle**, **Florence Dance Festival**, **Festival su Désert**, **Firenze Jazz Festival**, **Cirk Fantastik!**, **Lattexplus**, and many many other special events. BEST P&F RENTAL: A COSY TOWNHOUSE WITH A CHARMING TERRACE

Although not large, this is a cosy townhouse in a unique area of Florence close to the historic centre and to the countryside, near Bellosguardo for delightful walks and the terrace is spacious and

charming. This very small street is located on the south side of the river Arno, approx. 20 minutes walk to the river and the centre of the city. It is directly outside the medieval city walls of Florence, nestled at the base Bellosguardo hill. The closest main square, Piazza Tasso is equipped with playground facilities children for and numerous excellent restaurants and trattorias. THE SAN NICCOLO TOWER IS OPEN FOR VISITS

On the Festa di San Giovanni in June, the San Niccolò Tower is also opened for the season until the end of September. The medieval tower dates back to 1324 and once formed a part of the old walls around the city. It is the only one of the city towers to retain its original height of 60m (the others were lowered during the siege of 1529 to make them less vulnerable to cannonball fire). This year you can make the climb (around 200 steps) between 5pm and 8pm each day, with visits beginning every 30 minutes. For Bookings write to info@muse.comune.fi.it

BEST SUMMER ACTIVITY: BOAT RIDES ON THE MAGNIFICENT ARNO RIVER

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An hour's journey in which you will be welcomed by the river and sheltered from the hustle and bustle of the city, while the city of Florence flows by the sides of the boat. The profession of the Renaioli dates back to the beginning of the 20th century. Most of the boats were destroyed during the flood that struck Florence in 1966. In 1995, the Associazione dei Renaioli decided to restore them as they were part of the city's historical heritage. After retrieving the crafts from the riverbed, the members of the Association personally restored them following the traditional technique known as cafalatura. Today the Renaioli boats have been restored to their ancient splendor and are ready to carry you along the waters of the Arno river. BEST SUMMER SWIMMING POOL: LE PAVONIERE IN LE CASCINE PARK

The famous swimming pool of La Cascine park, with a restaurant, bar, open air swimming pools, and an outdoor stage for a nightclub set up during the summer nights! This is a huge favourite with locals. The days are more family oriented with expansive areas of grass for lounging beside the two pools, while the evenings see the venue become a popular nightspot for young people with music and dancing. BEST DINING OUT: VISIT NEARBY LUCCA FOR A SAGRA OF TRADITIONAL FARMER'S SNACKS COMBINED WITH A MOTORCYCLE FESTIVAL, "MOTOMERENDA DEL CONTADINO", July 17

(From <u>Discover Tuscany</u>) This is so much more than a sagra, it is also a fantastic motorcycle gathering through the streets of this little town in <u>Castelnuovo Garfagnana</u>. The menu of the "merenda" (the Italian word for afternoon snack) is a selection of dishes which have close ties to the traditions of the farmer, who worked the land and normally was extremely poor. As all over Tuscany, these are some of the most loved flavors of today, particular in this area rich in chestnut trees and recipe variations. The snacks are found on an itinerary which highlights the epoch of the farmer, and you can go to taste just one example or buy a ticket for the entire tour. These treats include "Formenton" polenta, porchetta, fried dough, and chestnuts. Read all about the many summer sagre in Tuscany here.

BEST OF THE REST

ESTATE FIESOLANA, Until September

Fiesole's Roman amphitheater is a step or two above your average spot for catching a Saturday night music gig or theatre show. Once again, the venue bridges the ancient past with artists of the present, hosting a series of summer shows in a range of genres. On Friday 21st June, the Roman Theatre, as is tradition, will host the day dedicated to Music Day, one of the most important events of cultural value celebrating the summer solstice in more than 120 countries around the world. 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APRITI CINEMA: THE STUNNING OUTDOOR CINEMA IN THE COURTYARD OF THE UFFIZI GALLERY, Until August 6

The big screen becomes the protagonist with "Apriti Cinema", the free-entrance festival conceived and coordinated by the Quelli dell'Alfieri Cultural Association, which brings the best of Italian and international auteur cinema to Piazzale degli Uffizi. The program includes films from international festivals, tributes for the centenary of the birth of Lauren Bacall and Marcello Mastroianni, the mini-exhibition "Uffizi Galleries – A film as a work of art", the Gabriele Salvatores retrospective of the Fiesole Award to the Masters of Cinema, the two days of Irish titles at the N.I.C.E. And again, a screening curated by Sentiero Film Factory, a tribute to the next author of the Monday evening retrospective at La Compagnia, Michelangelo Antonioni and an evening dedicated to inclusive cinema curated by INCinema – inclusive cinema festival; national previews in the presence of the directors. Florence has its own beaches along the Arno River. Naturally, bathing is strictly forbidden, but for those of you who don't like to go to the swimming pool or can't get to the seashore, this is a fun alternative. Head to "the beach" in San Niccolò where you can find umbrellas, sun loungers and other wooden gazebos. On the upper part of the beach there is the kiosk, part restaurant and part bar, for great food and drinks. With DJs and live music events, it's a known summer hotspot. OR go straight to the opposite side of the river banks, which erupts with the newest and freshest riverside offerings, including the much beloved Habana500 bar where salsa dancing erupts all summer alongside a volleyball net for spontaneous summer games. Don't miss all the new pop up restaurants and bars with stages for music, all stretched along the opposite side of the river along Lungarno della Zecca Vecchia. It's too hot to function some days in the city, and the need to find a pool is relentless, unless you're lucky enough to have a friend with one at home or a hotel with great amenities! If you're on the search for a quick dip, here are your best options. One small note: most pools now require a swimming cap for use.

EXHIBITIONS

ANSELM KIEFER ON SHOW AT PALAZZO STROZZI, Until July

Palazzo Strozzi presents a major exhibition dedicated to one of the greatest masters of the 20th and 21st century art, Anselm Kiefer. The exhibition allows direct contact with the art of the German artist thorough new and historical works that engage in a profound dialogue with the Renaissance architecture of Palazzo Strozzi, including a new work especially created for the palace's internal courtyard. Fallen Angel is a journey that reflects on topics such as identity, history, and philosophy. Through painting, sculpture, installation and photography, Kiefer's art offers deep introspection into the human condition, in a complex weaving of connections between the past, present and future. ART OF UZBEKISTAN ON SHOW AT PALAZZO PITTI, Until July 27

RETURNS: FROM MODIGLIANI TO MORANDI AT MUSEO NOVECENTO, Until September

(From <u>The Florentine Magazine</u>) Museo Novecento celebrates ten years since its inauguration in 2014 with a major exhibition titled Returns: From Modigliani to Morandi dedicated to the history of one of its most prized ensembles, the Alberto Della Ragione Collection. Donated to the City of

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Florence following the devastating flood in 1966, the works are now reunited with the invaluable masterpiece by the Livornese artist, Amedeo Modigliani. The idea conceived by the director of the museum, Sergio Risaliti, sees the rooms of the former Leopoldine on the second floor of the museum transformed for the occasion, with the exhibition curated by Eva Francioli, Chiara Toti and Sergio Risaliti on show until September 15. THE CATTEDRALE DELL'IMMAGINE PRESENTS INSIDE VAN GOGH

In the heart of Florence, the deconsecrated church of Santo Stefano al Ponte was reborn with the name "the Cathedral of the Image", transforming itself into the first permanent Italian center for Immersive Art Experiences. Now showing is *Inside Van Gogh*, the new immersive multimedia show, created by Crossmedia and directed by Stefano Fake. A 35-minute digital narrative developed through 360° multiprojection of high-definition images and the Dolby HD audio diffusion of a captivating soundtrack. Enjoy the complex human and artistic story of Vincent van Gogh, one of the most famous and beloved artists of all time. The multimedia experience is enriched by an educational introductory section with infographics and monitors, Oculus stations for experiencing the 3D virtual reality journey inside some famous paintings, and the immersive 'hall of mirrors,' an enveloping kaleidoscope of images located within the immersive hall. ESTATE FIESOLANA, Until September
