## BEST EVENT: BALAGÀN CAFÉ CELEBRATES 10 YEARS FOR SUMMER 2022

In the beautiful setting of the garden of Via Farini, in front of the imposing nineteenth-century Synagogue, Thursday evenings organized by the Jewish Community of Florence under the patronage of the Municipality of Florence. The Balagàn Cafè celebrates 10 years Summer 2022 Tuscany: Crossroads of cultures - Every Thursday from 30 June to 1 September in the garden of the Florence Synagogue. Opening at 19:00, from 19:30 you can enjoy a Jewish aperitif (minimum contribution of 10 euros), full of surprises and unusual flavors, drink a glass of kashèr wine to enjoy the evening. On the occasion of the Balagan Café it will be possible to visit the Synagogue at night with guided tours. ### BEST HOLIDAY: THE SUMMERTIME FERRAGOSTO NATIONAL HOLIDAY

Known as the day when absolutely everything is closed, Ferragosto is the key date during the Italian summer holidays. The 15th of August is the Feast of the Assumption, and marked the last day of the summer harvest and the start of a well-earned rest, traditionally in the form of a two-week holiday. Now, Italians take their holidays anytime during July to August, but the Ferragosto holiday holds strong and you can expect almost every Italian to have the day off. Do as they do, and treat yourself to a visit to the seaside, a picnic, or a party outdoors!

## BEST TRADITION: THE FEAST OF SAN LORENZO, August 10

San Lorenzo is the co-patron of Florence and every year on 10th August the San Lorenzo district becomes the place of the popular festival par excellence. The Basilica of San Lorenzo, which is also the first consecrated church in the city center, will be the center of all the celebrations. The community comes together in the evening for the traditional distribution of watermelon and lasagna at around 9pm in Piazza San Lorenzo, as well as a concert of classical music in the churchyard. The festivities begin with the Historic Procession of the Florentine Republic that starts at 10am from Piazzetta di Parte Guelfa and arrives at the Basilica in Piazza San Lorenzo, where a holy mass is celebrated.

## **OUTDOOR CINEMA AT VILLA BARDINI**

Every evening, until August 21, watch your favourite film at the outdoor cinema in the picturesque garden of Villa Bardini. For the third consecutive year, the summer arena on the Belvedere Terrace of the Bardini Garden returns with screenings, previews, and meetings with directors, actors and writers. On Thursdays, enjoy special evenings for children and families: with free admission but you must reserve (see the website). Free parking available in front of Forte Belvedere. The programming, curated by the Niels Stensen Cultural Foundation, will be divided into six thematic areas. Considering the attendance of foreign audiences as well, most of the Italian films will be shown with English subtitles; there will also be films in original sound, in various languages, with Italian subtitles. ### SUMMER AT LA LIMONAIA

The Limonaia of Villa Strozzi is one of the most important recreational and cultural centres in the city of florence, with a large indoor area where it is possible to eat or get together for an aperitif while enjoying concerts, screenings and quality shows. ## THE FESTIVALS OF ESTATE FIORENTINA 2022, TRE PASSI AVANTI

Music, cultural debates, art exhibitions, itinerant tours to discover Florence, literary festivals and talk shows. These are the ingredients of the 15 three-year festivals at the heart of the diffuse calendar of the Florentine Summer 2022. Space is given to all the arts: the international circus of Cirk Fantastik, readers are the protagonists with La città dei lettori that from Florence begins its tour of author presentations and debates around Tuscany, under the motto #leggereciunisce. For the music section, there are performances by world-famous artists of the Florence Jazz Festival, around the Oltrarno; the evocative concerts under the stars of "I Sagrati in musica". More music for the enhancement of traditions and cultures with Festival Au Désert. Lastly, the Copula Mundi gives voice to youth artistic realities active in the territory. Various arts and performances mingle with suggestive views of Florence from above, or in the debates and performances of Genius Loci inside the Monumental Complex of Santa Croce. For lovers of the seventh art, there is Apriti Cinema, the festival with screenings of art films, also in original language, by some of the most important and established realities in the sector, which will enjoy another panoramic view, the one in front of the Uffizi Gallery in Florence.

## TORRE DI SAN NICCOLO: CLIMB THE TOWER

Summer is the time that the San Niccolo Tower opens up for visitors. The medieval tower dates back to 1324 and once formed a part of the old walls around the city? it is the only one of the city towers to retain its original height of 60m (the others were lowered during the siege of 1529 to make them less vulnerable to cannonball fire). It's too hot to function some days in the city, and the need to find a pool is relentless, unless you're lucky enough to have a friend with one at home or a hotel with great amenities! Wanda Miletti Ferragamo: Wanda Ferragamo took over the reins of the family business when her husband died, transforming an artisan women's shoe workshop into a fashion house, thus changing her own life and that of her family. Starting from her figure, the exhibition describes the female reality in Italy between the 1950s and the 1960s, in the light of the deep socio-economic changes that characterised the years of the economic boom, with women searching for new life models, searching for a balance between work and family life.
