BEST HOLIDAY: THE SUMMERTIME FERRAGOSTO NATIONAL HOLIDAY

Known as the day when absolutely everything is closed, Ferragosto is the key date during the Italian summer holidays. The 15th of August is the Feast of the Assumption, and marked the last day of the summer harvest and the start of a well-earned rest, traditionally in the form of a two-week holiday. Now, Italians take their holidays anytime during July to August, but the Ferragosto holiday holds strong and you can expect almost every Italian to have the day off. Do as they do, and treat yourself to a visit to the seaside, a picnic, or a party outdoors!

Piazza Isidoro del Lungo is in a quiet residential area on the northern periphery of the historic centre of Florence. It is close to public transport and is approx 15 minutes from the Duomo (Florence cathedral) by foot and all the major museums and historical sights. San Marco square with the museum of the Fra Angelico frescos close by. This square is



also a hub for a lot of the municipal buses and being near the Accademia gallery, it is an area filed with coffee bars, restaurants and boutiques of all sorts. Food shopping is further afield in the San Lorenzo area. More information and photos here.

BEST TRADITION: THE FEAST OF SAN LORENZO, August 10

San Lorenzo is the co-patron of Florence and every year on 10th August the San Lorenzo district becomes the place of the popular festival par excellence. The Basilica of San Lorenzo, which is also the first consecrated church in the city center, will be the center of all the celebrations. The community comes together in the evening for the traditional distribution of watermelon and lasagna at around 9pm in Piazza San Lorenzo, as well as a concert of classical music in the churchyard. The festivities begin with the Historic Procession of the Florentine Republic that starts at 10am from

Piazzetta di Parte Guelfa and arrives at the Basilica in Piazza San Lorenzo, where a holy mass is celebrated.

BEST OF THE REST

BEST EVENT: ESTATE FIORENTINA 2025, THE SUMMER LONG FESTIVAL OF FESTIVALS CONTINUES, Until September

The Estate Fiorentina involves 139 entities, has 121 widespread projects, four special thematic events, nine large festivals, and 14 summer spaces. Some of this month's hottest events are:

<u>Cinema in Chiostro</u>: Great cinema returns to Sant'Orsola. Now in its sixth year, Cinema nel Chiostro, the summer film festival curated by Spazio Alfieri, will be held every evening at 9:30 pm from June 30th to September 7th, 2025. It will renew its collaboration with the Sant'Orsola Museum, transforming one of the courtyards of the former convent into an open-air theater for images, stories, and auteur visions

<u>Flog-On Plein Air</u>: The project was born from the synergy between La Chute and the new management of Flog, with the aim of giving the residents of Q5 and the entire city a new, green, inhabited and lively space within one of the emblematic places of culture, sport and entertainment in Florence, which has been off the radar for too long.

Estate Sotto Casa: #estatesottocasa6 aims to promote the historic "Conventino fuori le Mura" complex, showcasing traditional Florentine craftsmanship through cultural programming that uplifts the local community. Sustainability-focused events will also be held throughout the festival.

<u>Grillo Swing</u>: Grillo Swing returns for its eighth year, five evenings in the five neighborhoods of Florence dedicated to the Singing Cricket, accompanied by the music and songs of Odoardo Spadaro performed live. The evenings are part of Estate Fiorentina 2025, in collaboration with the Districts of the Municipality of Florence, and admission is free.

InStabile Chapiteau: A surprising program of world music concerts and contemporary circus shows, jam sessions, an open stage, and a spirit of innovation. All accompanied by a quality cocktail bar and kiosk, and refreshments featuring local and artisanal products.

<u>Sagrati in Musica</u>. These concerts will take place in Florentine churches and basilicas and will be performed by young musicians. The events are free and open to all!

NIGHTTIME OPENINGS OF THE VASARI CORRIDOR

From The Florentine Magazine: Beginning July 4 and running every Friday evening through December 26 (excluding August 15), the Vasari Corridor, which reopened last December after 8 years, will host special nighttime visits. These guided group tours do not require a ticket to the Uffizi Gallery and offer a rare opportunity to experience the corridor's unique architecture and atmosphere after dark. Tours run from 7-11pm, with ten slots per group running every 20 minutes. The visit lasts approximately 45 minutes, and full price admission is 20 euro. Advance booking is required either online, via call center, or in person at the museum's ticket office. A maximum of five tickets can be reserved per booking. The tour concludes in piazza Pitti, exiting through the Boboli Gardens via the Rondò di Bacco gate.

TRADITIONAL BOAT RIDES ON THE MAGNIFICENT ARNO RIVER

An hour's journey in which you will be welcomed by the river and sheltered from the hustle and bustle of the city, while the city of Florence flows by the sides of the boat. The profession of the Renaioli dates back to the beginning of the 20th century. Most of the boats were destroyed during the flood that struck Florence in 1966. In 1995, the Associazione dei Renaioli decided to restore them as they were part of the city's historical heritage. Today the Renaioli boats are ready to carry you along the waters of the Arno river. CINEMA IN VILLA: FILMS UNDER THE STARS ON THE TERRACE OF VILLA BARDINI

Films are screened at 9.15pm, with Thursday nights free for families, arthouse films for the dedicated film lovers, original language films, and a 50% discount on admission to the exhibition "Caravaggio and the Twentieth Century. This well-equipped space, inside the Garden of Horticulture in Florence, offers every evening various art and entertainment initiatives for adults and, for children, in the park not far from Piazza della Libertà. THE SAN NICCOLO TOWER IS OPEN FOR VISITS

The San Niccolò Tower is now open for the season until the end of September. The medieval tower dates back to 1324 and once formed a part of the old walls around the city. It is the only one of the city towers to retain its original height of 60m (the others were lowered during the siege of 1529 to make them less vulnerable to cannonball fire). This year you can make the climb (around 200 steps) between 5pm and 8pm each day, with visits beginning every 30 minutes. For Bookings write to info@muse.comune.fi.it

EXHIBITIONS

HUMANITAS - LA FORZA DELL'AMORE, THE FORCE OF LOVE, Until August

The Basilica di San Lorenzo complex host's Humanitas - La Forza dell'Amore, which presents Andrea Roggi's monumental bronze sculptures and establishes a connection with the history and spatial setting of the site. The Tree of Life, a favorite subjecto for the Tuscan artist, is represented in his works through the union of matter and spirit: his human figures, embracing each other in a synthesis of strength and tenderness, look like tree trunks and their arms, turned towards the sky, become olive branches, while the roots, inserted into the globe, represent the deep and essential bond with nature. TIME FOR WOMEN! EMPOWERING VISIONS IN 20 YEARS OF THE MAX MARA ART PRIZE, AT THE STROZZINA, Until August

Palazzo Strozzi and Collezione Maramotti present Time for Women!, an exhibition celebrating the 20th anniversary of the Max Mara Art Prize for Women, one of the most significant awards dedicated to supporting female-identifying artists, created as a collaboration between Max Mara, Whitechapel Gallery, and Collezione Maramotti. The show will present the works of the nine artists who have won the prize since its inception in 2005: Margaret Salmon (1975, New York), Hannah Rickards (1979, UK), Andrea Büttner (1972, Germany), Laure Prouvost (1978, France), Corin Sworn (1975, UK), Emma Hart (1974, UK), Helen Cammock (1970, UK), Emma Talbot (1969, UK), and Dominique White (1993, UK).
