BEST EVENT: AUTUMN SHOW MARKET OF PLANTS AND FLOWERS BY THE TUSCAN HORTICULTURAL SOCIETY, October 4-6

From the first weekend in October, meet at the Horticultural Garden of Florence for the Autumn Show Market of plants and flowers, organised by the Tuscan Horticultural Society, a non-profit association, with headquarters and library at Villa Bardini in Costa San Giorgio, 2. The entrance is free with more than 70 exhibitors including the best Tuscan nurserymen and beyond. The first edition of the Spring Show Market was in 1855, in the Panciatichi Marquis garden in Borgo Pinti, followed immediately with another in autumn with over one hundred exhibitors. The story of the first shows is published serially on the organisation's Bulletin, a quarterly magazine sent free of charge to members and available in pdf on the site. Website.

BEST TRADITION: THE FEAST OF SANTA REPARATA, October 8

October 8th commemorates one of the patron saints of Florence: Santa Reparata. She was a virgin martyr who lived in Palestine during the 3rd century, who died when taken captive by Romans who attempted to burn her to death, yet she survived, and so they beheaded her. She was adopted by Florence as a patron saint. Hidden in the ground beneath the Duomo is the Santa Reparata Cathedral – which the Cattedrale di Santa Maria del Fiore (the Duomo) was built above. There have been many excavation campaigns over the last decades, and you can now see some of these fascinating and important remains in a crypt beneath the nave. Programme of the celebrations and the historical

parade: at 9.15am the historical procession accompanies the municipal authorities to the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, starting from Palagio di Parte Guelfa (through Via Porta Rossa, Piazza del Mercato Nuovo, Via Vacchereccia, Piazza della Signoria); at 9.45am: arrival at the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore and, in the crypt of Santa Reparata, offering of the candle and the wreath in honour of Santa Reparata.

BEST EXHIBITION: XXXIII BIENNALE INTERNAZIONALE DI ANTIQUARIATIO AT PALAZZO CORSINI, Until October 6

The International Antiques Biennial takes place in Florence, as the name suggests every two years. The 2024 Biennale is the 33rd edition of an event that is an absolute reference for great Italian art. "A museum for sale" is how the General Secretary of the Biennale, Fabrizio Moretti, defined it: approximately 80 galleries bring unknown works of art to the banks of the Arno, creating an exhibition of the highest level. Among the artists, works by Bronzino, Tiziano Vecellio, Giovanna Garzoni, Andrea Appiani, Vittorio Corcos, Umberto Boccioni, Antonietta Raphael, Alberto Savinio are on display in the rooms of Palazzo Corsini. The exhibition is completed by many events with glamorous guests: gala dinners, musical shows for charity, artistic-themed conferences, which take place both at Palazzo Corsini and in various museums of the city. The Biennale itself takes place in the exceptional beauty of Palazzo Corsini sull'Arno, normally closed to the public, a rare example of a Baroque building in the city of Florence. EXHIBITIONS

HELEN FRANKENTHALER, PAINTING WITHOUT RULES, EXHIBITION AT PALAZZO STROZZI, Until January 26

From: The Florentine Magazine. With her innovative soak-stain technique, the artist left her mark on the evolution of modern painting in a new relationship between colour, space and form. From September 27 to January 26, 2025, Palazzo Strozzi hosts Helen Frankenthaler. Painting Without Rules, a major exhibition celebrating one of the most important women artists of the 20th century, whose revolutionary research in painting is explored through works from her oeuvre between 1953 and 2002, in dialogue with paintings and sculptures by her contemporaries, including Jackson Pollock, Morris Louis, Robert Motherwell, Mark Rothko, David Smith and Anne Truitt. DO NOT ABANDON ME: LOUISE BOURGEOIS AT MUSEO NOVECENTO, Until Oct 20

Two exceptional exhibitions – the first one at Museo Novecento Do Not Abandon Me and the other at Museo degli Innocenti Cell XVIII (Portrait). The project brings the works of Louise Bourgeois (Paris, 1911 – New York, 2010) to Florence for the first time, building a significant relationship of osmosis between her creations and the exhibition context. Conceived in close dialogue with the architecture of the former Leopoldine building, a complex with a strong social vocation run for centuries by all-female communities, the exhibition will give the opportunity to experience almost one hundred works by the artist. These will include many gouaches made during the last five years of Bourgeois's life, that explore the cycles of life through an iconography of sexuality, procreation, birth, motherhood, feeding, dependency, the couple, the family unit, and flowers. OLTRECITTA': IMAGINING THE CITY, AT VILLA BARDINI, Until January 19

From: The Florentine Magazine. Spread over two floors of Villa Bardini, 126 works by modern and contemporary artists offer thought-provoking answers. What is a city? That is the question at the heart of the latest collaboration between the Bardini Foundation and Lucia Fiaschi, curator of the show OltreCittà: Utopias and Reality along with Bruno Corà, Silvia Mantovani and Claudia Bucelli. Spread over two floors of Villa Bardini, 126 works by a myriad of modern and contemporary artists offer thought-provoking answers. Open until January 19, 2025 and featuring heavy hitters like Sol LeWitt, Boccioni, Burri, de Chirico, Le Corbusier and Pistoletto, the exhibit is divided into 12 themed sections presenting different creative perspectives on the built environment. These include "Utopias", "Hostile City" and "City Maps", and each section is enriched by quotes from likes of

MUSEO MARINO MARINI: THE TREASURE OF THE HOLY LAND EXHIBITION, Until January 7

In the heart of Florence, the deconsecrated church of Santo Stefano al Ponte was reborn with the name "the Cathedral of the Image", transforming itself into the first permanent Italian center for Immersive Art Experiences. Now showing is Inside Klimt. Gustav Klimt, the most famous of the founders of the Viennese Secession, was also the protagonist of Klimt Experience, the first production by Crossmedia Group. In the treasure chest of the Cathedral of the Image that today you will come into contact with the art and life of Gustav Klimt, a revolutionary artist and creator of some of the most iconic pieces in the history of modern art. You will see him at the beginning and at the end of his career, passing through his greatest successes and glimpsing some moments of his private life. On October 19, the Teatro Verdi will host the BEST OF Tour of the Glenn Miller Orchestra, the world's most beloved swing and jazz ensemble. Trombonist, conductor and composer, author of famous songs such as "Moonlight Serenade", Glenn Miller was one of the most important and influential musicians of the twentieth century, an authentic icon of the Swing Era: exactly eighty years after his death, his myth continues to live and the songs to play in the main theaters with his Glenn Miller Orchestra, the most loved swing and jazz ensemble in the world.
