Via Romana is a long narrow street on the south side of the river. It commences at Piazza Pitti and terminates at the Porta Romana, one of the gates to the historic city. This gate and street were given the same name as they were the direction one took to go to Rome. The river Arno is about a 20 minutes walk from the apartment, as is the famous Ponte Vecchio. Piazza Santo Spirito, featuring Brunelleschi's beautiful Church of the same name, and a daily food and clothing market are approx. 15 minutes away. BEST TRADITION: THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION, CHRISTMAS, AND SANTO STEFANO FEATURING THE DUOMO CHRISTMAS TREE AND NATIVITY SCENE,

December 8

December 8 in Italy is a national holiday that celebrates the Immaculate Conception. This day of festivity unofficially starts the countdown to Christmas as many Italian families traditionally use this day to set up and decorate their Christmas tree and Nativity scene in their homes. On December 8 in Florence's historic centre the large Christmas tree is set up in Piazza del Duomo. The lighting of the

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Christmas tree is accompanied by an official public ceremony with the participation of Florence's Mayor. Also in Piazza del Duomo, the impressive Nativity Scene is built in the front and left of the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore. The Nativity has life-sized beautiful statues made in terracotta by an artisan of Impruneta. Both the Christmas tree and the Nativity scene are up until January 6, the day of Epiphany. In the Cathedral of Florence, the traditional Christmas Eve Mass is celebrated by the Cardinal of Florence at midnight (Vigil prayers start at 11pm). On Christmas morning, the Mass is celebrated at 10:30am, in conjunction with the Pope's blessing in Rome.

BEST EXHIBITION: ANISH KAPOOR AT PALAZZO STROZZI, Until February 2024

Until 4 February 2024 Fondazione Palazzo Strozzi presents a major exhibition conceived and realised with Anish Kapoor, the celebrated master who has revolutionised the idea of sculpture in contemporary art. Through historical and recent works, including a new production specifically conceived in dialogue with the architecture of the Renaissance courtyard, Untrue Unreal is an itinerary that winds its way through monumental installations, intimate spaces and perturbing forms: Palazzo Strozzi becomes a place concave and convex, whole and shattered at the same time, in which the visitor is called upon to question his or her senses. BEST FESTIVAL: "Green-Line": THE FESTIVAL OF LIGHT THAT ILLUMINATES FLORENCE, December 8 to January 7

From December the 8th to January 7th Florentines and tourists will be invited to take part in a light journey, an imaginary trip from the city's squares to the celestial vault. After the great success of the last editions, Florence is preparing to light up with "Green-Line": the recently rebranded Florence Light Festival that sheds new light on the monuments and squares of the city. The event will offer video-mapping, projections, light games, artistic installations, educational activities, special visits to museums, shows and cultural meetings. As usual, many spaces of the city will be involved: on all Ponte Vecchio, Palazzo Vecchio, Palazzo Medici Riccardi, Piazza Santa Maria Novella and the Oltrarno, with particular attention to the Towers and the city gates and the neighborhoods outside the historic center. The lights will be jointly turned on Saturday, December 8th when the Christmas tree in front of the Duomo is switched on. Website.

BEST DINING OUT: DINING IN THE DARK AT LA TRATTORIA IL GIARDINO, December 5

Are you curious about what it is like to dine in the dark? The absence of sight can enhance our other senses and the way we interact with others. Dining in the Dark offers you the chance to experience this first-hand as you taste delicious dishes in one of the city's best restaurants, the beautiful Trattoria il Giardino. This charming restaurant serves delicious Tuscan dishes cooked by chef Edgardo Ambrosini and his talented team. In the 120 minutes that the blindfolded dinner lasts, you will be served a three-course meal full of flavour, but without being able to see the food on your plate. The only clue as to what you are eating will be the scent of the food as it wafts around involving your other senses. You can choose three menu options in advance: meat, fish and vegan. 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NEW YEAR'S EVE CELEBRATIONS, December 31

Put your warmest coat over your fanciest clothes (and perhaps some long undies) and head to central Florence for at least three free outdoor concerts. While the final schedule is yet to be announced, traditionally Piazza della Signora hosts a classical concert starting around 11:15 pm. This year look for jazz, pop and rock to be happening in all the major piazzas including Piazza della Signoria, Piazza San Lorenzo and Piazza Carmine. If you're looking for a party with all the works, The Hard Rock Cafe is famous for their New Year's party, or you could ring in the New Year at Manifattura Tabacchi, Tuscany Hall, Space Nightclub, or XO Club and Lounge, where there'll be huge parties going all night. With all of Florence theatre's also staging special events and performances, you can choose the ambience right for you to celebrate the New Year in Florence! DOMENICOALMUSEO: STATE MUSEUMS FREE FOR EVERYONE, AND CIVIC MUSEUMS FREE FOR RESIDENTS ON THE FIRST SUNDAY OF EVERY MONTH

On the first Sunday of every month, Florence opens up all of its state and civic museums free for residents of the city, or people born here. Here's a list of the state museums free to all: Uffizi,

SPECIAL CHRISTMAS MARKETS

Mercatino in a Palazzo: "Natale per file" kicks off at the Palazzo Corsini from December 15-17 One of the most treasured events of the December calendar, this Christmas market raises funds for charities held every year in Palazzo Corsini. You'll find gourmet products and gift ideas, with proceeds going toward the non-profit organisation FILE's palliative care support. Christmas market under Florence's Ferris wheel

This year, Florence's Ferris wheel is changing location and moving from the Fortezza da Basso to the Cascine Park, to remain there longer, not only during the Christmas festivities. The Municipality of Florence has published the notice to select the company that will set up the big attraction in Piazza Vittorio Veneto. The Croce Rossa Italiana Christmas Market from December 2 and 3

The 2022 edition of the Christmas market will be held at the historic headquarters of the Florence Committee of the Italian Red Cross, at Palazzo Capponi, (with entrance also from Via Borgo san Frediano 12). Also for this year, the entire proceeds of the Christmas Market will be exclusively dedicated to the assistance of needy families in the Florentine territory. For more than 25 years, the Christmas Market has been the main source of funding thanks to which the volunteers of the Florence Red Cross can support the more than 2,000 people in our city who are in need, sickness, social reintegration problems and families with disadvantaged minors. Christmas at Manifattura Tabacchi, December 2&3, 9&10, 16&17

A small Christmas village of charming wooden huts, with open areas of tables and chairs where you can sit and enjoy some of the rich German food on offer. EXHIBITIONS

CHINI 150, CELEBRATING 150 YEARS OF FLORENTINE ARTIST GALILEO CHINI

On the occasion of the celebrations for the 150th anniversary of Galileo Chini's birth, the <u>Chini Museum</u> of Borgo San Lorenzo, which collects the artistic production of the Chini family, presents an anthological exhibition dedicated to the Florentine artist, with works ranging from the period of the Fornaci San Lorenzo to his last works. The opening of the exhibition will be on 2 December at 5pm, with readings of passages on the life of Galileo Chini by the theatre company Teatro Idea. <u>Read more here</u>.

CECILY BROWN: TEMPTATIONS, TORMENTS, TRIALS AND TRIBULATIONS AT MUSEO NOVECENTO

From 30 September, the Museo Novecento and the Bianca Cappello Room in Palazzo Vecchio will host the works of one of its most talented exponents of contemporary painting, the English painter Cecily Brown, who more than any other has been able to reinvent the relationship between contemporary art and the great figurative art of past centuries. The exhibition brings together more than thirty works, most of them previously unpublished, born from a reflection on the Temptations of St. Anthony, a subject that has been widely investigated by artists over the centuries, from Michelangelo Buonarroti to Hieronimus Bosch, from Paul Cézanne to Odillon Redon, and taken up by a colour reproduction of an engraving by the German artist Martin Schongauer. The artist is exhibiting his work for the first time in Florence at the Museo Novecento and Palazzo Vecchio, in what promises to be the most sophisticated and exciting exhibition of the year, curated by Sergio Risaliti. ARTEMISIA NEL MUSEO DI MICHELANGELO, AT CASA BUONARROTI

The exhibition "Artemisia nel Museo di Michelangelo", curated by Museum Director Alessandro Cecchi, and designed by Massimo Chimenti of Cultura Nuova, is located in three rooms on the ground floor of Casa Buonarroti. The first places Artemisia in the context of her new city, Florence, where she found herself part of the social and cultural circle of the poet Michelangelo the Younger. Here she became the first woman painter to be admitted to the Accademia del Disegno, made the acquaintance of Galileo Galilei and obtained commissions from the top echelons of Florentine society, including the Grand Duke Cosimo II. MAPPLETHORPE - VON GLOEDEN. BEAUTY AND DESIRE, ON DISPLAY AT MUSEO NOVECENTO, Until February 2024

From September 23 to February 14, 2024, the Museo Novecento pays tribute to one of the most significant figures in 20th-century photography, Robert Mapplethorpe, in a unique comparison with the photographs of Wilhelm von Gloeden and a selection of photographs from the Alinari Archive. The exhibition is the second major exhibition of this museum dedicated to photography, a practice that has revolutionized the history of art since the 19th century. "Beauty and Desire" draws inspiration from a series of artworks that highlights Mapplethorpe's intense artistic production, emphasizing the connection between his work and classical aesthetics, as well as his sculptural approach to photography, which is evident in his studies of both male and female nudes and still life, equating bodies with objects in a sculptor's vision and sensibility. ART NOUVEAU ON DISPLAY AT THE MUSEO DEGLI INNOCENTI, Until April 2024

From 27 October 2023 to 7 April 2024 the Museo degli Innocenti is welcoming the first exhibition in Florence dedicated to Alphonse Mucha, the most important Czech artist, father of Art Nouveau and creator of iconic images. In the late 19th and early 20th century, Paris was considered the capital of art world. It was the period of the so-called Belle Époque, there was great enthusiasm, and Alphonse Mucha, also thanks to his meeting with Sara Bernhardt, became the most famous and disputed artist of the time. His works, illustrations, theatre posters and nascent advertising became available to all. It is to this exceptional artist that Arthemisia and the Museo degli Innocenti are dedicating the upcoming great Florentine exhibition. Website.
